Ratifications

“the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia” ratified the European Social Charter on 31/03/2005. It has accepted 41 of the Charter’s 72 paragraphs. It has signed but not yet ratified Protocol which adds new rights. It has not signed nor ratified the Revised Charter.

“the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia” ratified the Protocol reforming the control mechanism on 31/03/2005.
